BATTLE OF THE 80S NUMBER 1 HITS

Which song was the bigger hit?

You will get to choose 4 songs from the 1980s. You may know your songs or you may not have heard your songs – you can pick whatever you choose. Then you will compare your 4 songs using several statistics to determine which one was the bigger 1980s hit.

You want to create an organized, well thought-out, display of all information below. Make it easy for the reader to understand all your data.

- 1. Choose your 4 songs based on the criteria on the song page.
- 2. For each of your songs, Mr. Mangham will provide you with how that tune performed while in the Top 40.
- 3. With this information determine and create the following in **THE CHARTS** section:

SECTION 1

- List the entire chart run
- Weeks at #1 position
- Weeks in the top 10
- Weeks in the top 40

SECTION 2

- Using all the weeks in the Top 40 determine the:
 - Mean (hundredth), median, mode, and range
 - Lower quartile, Upper quartile, Interquartile range
 - Mean absolute deviation (hundredth)

SECTION 3

• A separate dot plot of the Top 10 data for each song

SECTION 4

• A box plot of the data for each song all using the same number line

SECTION 5

• Your scoring system based on the chart data explained. Think carefully about what seems to be a fair scoring system using all your data.

SECTION 6

• Ranking – the songs listed first, second, third, fourth based on your scoring system

4. Next, survey at least 10 adults (21+ years old) that have good knowledge of 1980s hits including your 4 of your songs.

10 adults = maximum grade on the project = 90

14 adults = maximum grade on the project = 95

18+ adults = maximum grade on the project = 100

Ask each person to rank the songs from 1st to 4th. With this information determine and create the following in the **SURVEY** section:

SECTION 1

- A table showing all the results of your survey including the total points earned by each song.
 - Use the following to determine the total points:

5 points for a 1st place vote, 3 points for 2nd place vote

2 points for a 3rd place vote, 1 point for a 4th place vote

SECTION 2

• A bar graph showing the total points earned by each song

SECTION 3

- Ranking the songs listed first, second, third, fourth based on the survey results
- 5. Make sure to listen to all 4 of your songs if you have not heard them before (Mr. Mangham can play them for you if you wish). With this information determine and create the following in the **SURVEY** section:

SECTION 1

• A brief opinion as to the strengths and/or weaknesses of each song. How does the song make your feel? What specifics about the song make you feel this way?

SECTION 2

- Ranking the songs listed first, second, third, fourth based on your opinion
- 6. On the very bottom line list your OVERALL BATTLE CHAMPION based on some combination of the three rankings.
