## **Edmodo Guidelines and Code of Conduct for Mr. Mangham's Class**

### **Posting Messages**

- Posts are for school-related, math-related content only.
- Sample postings: homework assignment questions (directions, question numbers, how to show work), due date questions, how to start a difficult problem, class notes questions, general math skill questions.
- Don't post "What is the answer to number..."
- Don't post "I don't understand the homework." Ask a specific question.
- Post a note to the whole group if your question is about something the whole group can help answer.
- Message Mr. Mangham if you want to talk about something that doesn't relate to everyone.
- Don't post personal questions to the group.
- Refrain from posts that tease, bully, annoy, spam, or gossip about any other member.

### **Punctuation & Grammar**

- No txtng lingo. We r ur teachers...show us that u have learned how 2 spell.
- DO NOT PUT SENTENCES IN ALL CAPITAL LETTERS.
- Do not end sentences with more than one exclamation mark!!!!!!!!!!!!!! Or question mark?????????????
- Please please please do not repeat a word more than necessary.
